Reminder

As the school is needed as a polling station, the school will be closed to pupils tomorrow. Friday is also an INSET day as we thought families might want to take a long weekend during school closure rather than taking children out during term time. This is just a reminder as you have had advanced notice of these two INSET days since the Autumn Term.

Sun Safety

Please ensure your children have sun cream applied before school. Creams may be brought in to re-apply but no sprays please. ALL children should bring hats clearly labelled with their name. Water bottles may also be brought in to school to ensure pupils have regular intake of water. Drinking water taps are available to refill the bottles.

Summer Uniform

Please remember that Summer Uniform must be appropriate for school. Summer dresses, white, gold, or burgundy polo shirts with plain black, or grey skirts, shorts or trousers. If pupils arrive in multi coloured tops and shorts parents will be contacted and asked to bring in appropriate clothing. PE Kit should also be T-shirts and shorts, no strappy vests or sleeveless tops. Footwear should be appropriate for outdoor play – NO FLIP FLOPS PLEASE.

Cakes

If you wish your child's class to have some Birthday cake, please send it in ready sliced and wrapped ready for the children to take home with them. There are many children with allergies and families who do not wish their children to have cake so it would then allow parents to make the choice after school.

Back Lane Access

Some parents have raised concerns about the back lane. If you use the back car park when collecting your children please try and exit via Stanwell Road rather than driving down Meliden Lane which is used by many of our Parents and children who choose to walk to and from school.

Parking in front of school

Please remember that parking on the zigzag lines by the pedestrian crossing is an offence. Cars parked near the crossing obstruct the vision of other drivers putting lives at risk. Please park at a sensible distance from school and walk your children in to school or *Walk All the Way!*
