November 16 – 20 national Anti-bullying week

As part of their PSE programme the children will participate in activities that raise their awareness of different types of bullying, what to do if they are bullied and how to cope with bullying behaviour.

The Personal & Social Education programme is based around the SEAL scheme.

Parents have an opportunity to learn more about this by joining us at 6.30pm in the Upper Hall on Wednesday November 18th.

There will be a free crèche in the nursery building run by school staff.

The meeting will run for about an hour.
